**You need:**

- Dice
- Counters

**How to play?**

- 1 Play the game in pairs or in groups.
- 1 Set the counters to START.
- 2 Roll the dice. Count the numbers on the dice aloud.
- 3 Move to the right field. Say what is in the field.  
Move forward if you answer correctly.
- 4 The first player to reach FINISH is the winner!

**New words:**

- start
- finish
- Miss a turn!

# COLOURS



## You need:

- Board
- A marker or chalk

## New words:

- blue, yellow, orange, green, red, pink
- a carrot, an apple, a banana, milk, the sun, a flower, a caterpillar, a balloon, a fish, a pencil, a ball

## How to play?

Play the game in three groups. Each group chooses a name.

- 1 The teacher writes the numbers 1-12 on the board. Each number is one question.
- 2 Each group chooses one number. One student in the group answers the question. Other group members may help.
- 3 Get a point for each correct answer.
- 4 The winner is the group with the highest score.

## Teacher says:

- 1 What does the word *blue* mean?
- 2 What colour is the sun?
- 3 What is orange and green?  
Ronnie likes it.
- 4 Sing *The Colour Song*!
- 5 Find the odd one out: an apple, a banana, a carrot, a flower?
- 6 Say it in Croatian: *I don't like milk*.

- 7 Say three words from the pink balloon.

- 8 How many flowers can you see?  
Count!

- 9 Say it in English: *Volim mlijeko*.

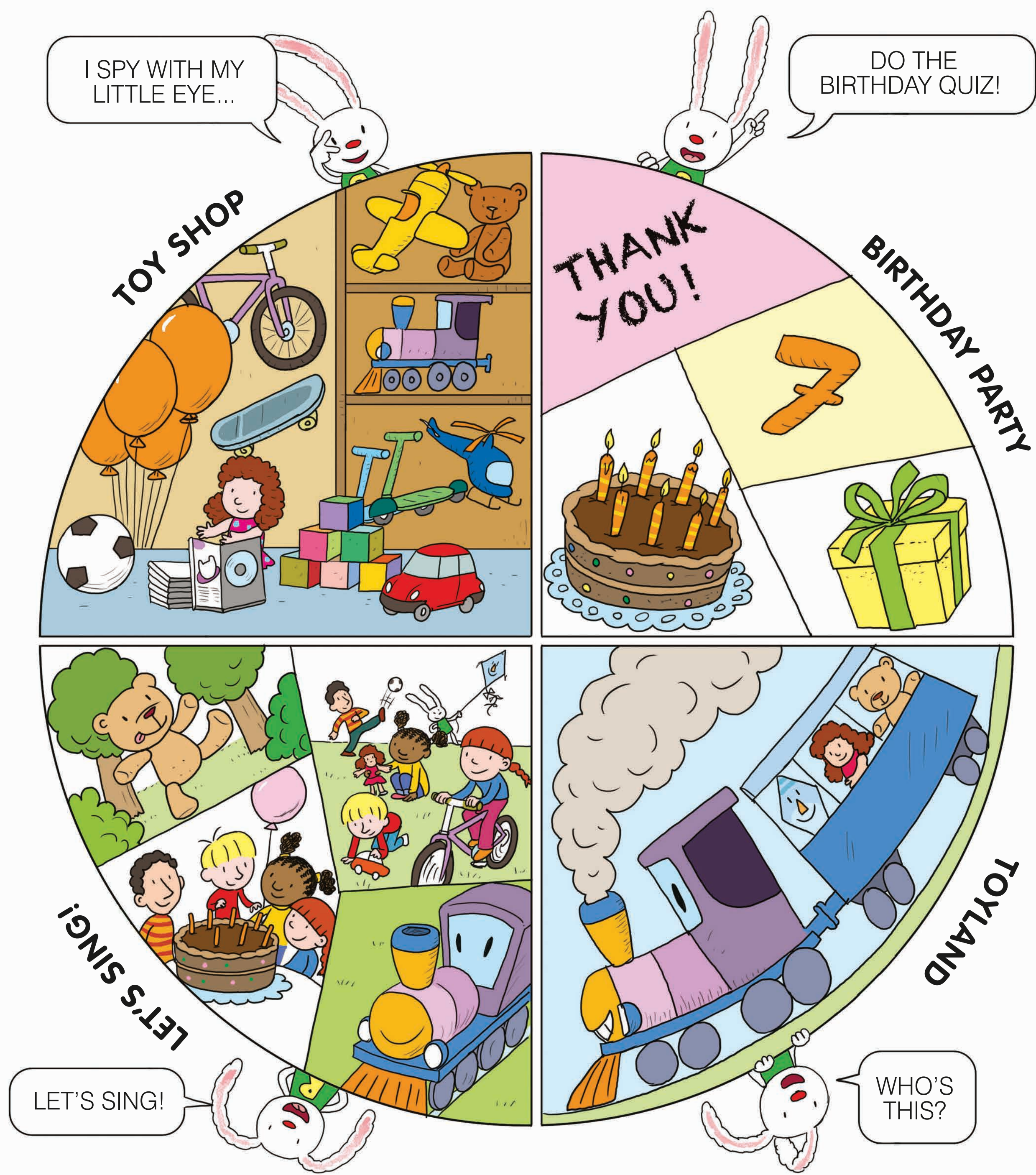
- 10 Who is this?

- 11 What does the caterpillar always say?

- 12 What colours can you see in the balloon?



# RONNIE IN TOYLAND



## You need:

- Board
- Flashcards
- Pieces of paper
- Notebooks

## New words:

- orange, yellow, blue, red, green, pink, white, brown, black
- scooter, balloon, seven, plane, skateboard, train, car, helicopter, videogame, ball, building blocks, bike, teddy bear, kite, doll
- birthday present, birthday card, birthday cake

## How to play?

Play the games in groups. Each group chooses a name.

### I SPY WITH MY LITTLE EYE

- Play the game in three to four groups.
- Paste flashcards with pictures of toys around the classroom.
- Choose a student from each group to play. The student says: *I spy with my little eye something red! I spy with my little eye something orange! ...*
- For each correct answer the group gets a point.

### THE BIRTHDAY QUIZ

- Play the game in two groups.
- Draw a grid with numbers 1-6 on the board.
- Students choose a number and answer the corresponding question.  
**1** How old is Greg?; **2** Who are his friends?; **3** What have they got for Greg?; **4** Is Greg happy?; **5** Where are the candles?; **6** How many candles are there?
- For each correct answer the group gets a point.

### LET'S SING!

- Play the game in four groups.
- Prepare pieces of paper with song titles. Song titles: *Round and Round the Garden*, *Happy Birthday*, *A Toy Song*, *Here Comes the Train*.
- Each group draws out a piece of paper with a song title. The group has to sing the song to get a point.

### TOYLAND

- Each student chooses one of the characters from the story, draws it and writes its name in their notebook.
